


# Inner peace







Bench 9 in teak with hot galvanized base.


Sunlounger A3 and Footstool A3 in teak with hot galvanized base.

## The Classic series

The Classic series is based on Armchair A2, which was launched at the 1930 Stockholm Exhibition, and its family tree continues to grow. This comfortable chair with its clean lines and characteristic rocking sensation is designed to bring hours of relaxation and joy – generation after generation.



The furniture in the Classic Series work equally well either separately or combined. Place a solitary chair or sofa in your outdoor space to create an inviting place for daydreaming and new perspectives.

All wood is sourced from forests that are managed responsibly, and we manufacture the furniture at our factory in Grythyttan, just as we have always done.



# Andreas Engesvik




High Tech Chair, hot galvanized. High Tech Table 60, hot galvanized with white compact laminate top.

The Brewery Series is available in teak or in oak with an oiled or white lacquer finish. The wooden components are FSC<sup>®</sup> certified, and we make the furniture at our factory in Grythyttan to ensure complete control of the production process, just as we've always done.



# Akleja

The Akleja furniture series is the result of a collaboration between Grythyttan Stålmöbler and the Swedish designer Jonas Bohlin. The chair and the table came about during work on Tommy Myllymäki's restaurant AIRA – an environment shaped by the winds tumbling across Saltsjön and clearly reflected in the materials and construction.

The series includes a chair and a table in untreated teak resting on dark grey bases of steel tubing.





Jonas Bohlin

Jonas Bohlin is one of the most famous designers and interior architect in Sweden. His commissions include a number of legendary Stockholm restaurants, such as Riche, Teatergrillen and Sturehof. Back in 1981, he also designed the Concrete chair, which received the Excellent Swedish Design award.

# We care about our trees

When buying one of our products, naturally you are entitled to know where the material comes from and how it was produced. This is why we work with certification and ecolabelling, enabling you to always track the material throughout the entire production chain, from raw material to finished product.

#### **FSC**<sup>®</sup>

Our teak and South American oak components are certified FSC® 100%. The FSC® works for the environmentally friendly, socially responsible and economically viable management of the world's forests. The FSC® is an international organization with its members spanning various environmental organizations, social organizations and financial stakeholders.



**Not all pine is created equal.** Since our furniture is to be of the highest quality, we only use timber with standing annual rings in our pine furniture. This means that the annual rings are parallel to the short side with no risk of the planks warping. This also ensures a harder product surface with wooden components that better retain their shape and are less prone to cracking.

## PEFC

Our pine components are PEFC certified by the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification. PEFC is an international organization with its members comprising various forest companies. The organization works to promote sustainable forestry with a focus on environmental, economic and social aspects.

The wooden components of our furniture have environmen-

tal certificates from two leading organizations who share our

view of responsible forestry. These certificates guarantee






#### HIGH TECH SERIES





#### LIBELLE


